Collision with Ambulance

Fochville – A man was killed and four other people injured, two of whom critically, when the light motor vehicle they were travelling in collided head-on with an ambulance on President Street in Fochville during the early hours of Friday morning.

Two paramedics were seriously injured.

The cause of the accident and the series of events leading up to it remain unclear and will form the subject of a South African Police Force investigation. "Common cause information indicates that the vehicle veered into the path of the ambulance. The two collided and the force of impact saw the ambulance leave the road," Jeffrey Wicks, Media Liaison Officer, Netcare 911, said.

Netcare911 and Provincial Paramedics arrived on the scene only to find that the front seated passenger of the car was killed on impact. The driver was in a critical condition along with a term mother who was seated in the back of the car. Two other men were also in a serious condition.

The driver of the car was airlifted by the Netcare1 Aeromedical Helicopter to the Chris Hani Baragwanath Hospital.

The other wounded were transported by ambulance to a state hospital in Carltonville.

Both paramedics were in a serious condition and were transported by ambulance to the Leslie Williams Hospital. Their patient was not injured in the collision.
